During the fundraiser for women in need due to the Plumb Place closure, you helped us raise \$1,784.64 in cash donations from December 16th to December 31st! This total does not include the gift cards which are specified below. Including the 5 gift cards, that monetary total comes to \$1,909.64, which we rounded to 1914.00 for an even amount to each home!

- 6/6 identified as women

- 2/6 identified their race as white/caucasian
- 3/6 identified their race as black/african american
- 1/6 identified her race as indigenous / native american

Age

- 1/6 was an accompanied youth, age 17.
- 1/6 was an unaccompanied youth, age 21.
- 3/6 were adults over 25 and under 60
- 1/6 was an adult over 60

Services Received

- 6/6 received assistance moving furniture and other donated goods
- 5/6 received \$185 in monetary donations that can be used for food, rent and utilities, clothing, etc. This consisted of five \$25 walmart gift cards and five \$160 prepaid visa cards, which was the cash donations we had received divided among all the households.
- 2/6 received move-in deposits (\$455 and \$200)
- 1/6 received help paying for her medications for two months (\$124)
- 1/6 received help paying for her phone services for two months (\$60)
- 6/6 received food donations, or cash directly for food (\$40)
- 1/6 received an Amazon gift card for \$50 to buy her daughter Christmas gifts
- 3/6 received cat litter, cat food, and other needed items for their pets.

Just the cash breakdown

- \$655 for move-in deposits
- \$124 for monthly medication
- \$60 for phone bill
- \$60 for Jensen's Self Store-It for the month of January as one of the women is unable to move into her apartment until January 15th.
- \$50 for Christmas gift for 17 year old daughter of one of the residents.
- \$40 for dinner for two homes on new years eve.
- \$125 in Walmart gift cards divided among the 5 adults. They each received a \$25 gift card.
- \$800 in prepaid Visa cards divided among the 5 adults which can be used to assist in bill pay, groceries, etc - accepted anywhere Visa is accepted. They each received a \$160 prepaid card.
